The Berry Patch School's play-based program incorporates intentional and systematic learning experiences. Four characteristics define our comprehensive program.

- 1. Active, rather than passive participation.
- 2. Meaningful experiences, relating to learner outcomes.
- 3. Engaging stations and activities to encourage children to be attentive.
- 4. Socially interactive allowing children to work together to improve relational skills.

Specific learning objectives are taught in direct instructional methods with the teacher leading the learning. Children then move into guided play and free play to practice and learn skills and concepts. Specific outcomes are associated with both guided play (adult coached) and free play (independent) activities in the classroom relating to overall learning objectives.
